- Andres will be sending out a whenisgood form to determine ExComm meeting dates.
- Some committees are accepting new members:

- Andres has sent out the task force proposal forms, which task force leaders should fill out as soon as possible.
 - USG members are required to lead or serve on at least one task force.

2. Budget Proposal: Rachel Hazan (10 minutes)

- Budget allocations for elections and TigerApps will remain the same.
- There are fewer expenses than usual for the core committees.

- The Movies Committee budget allocation is \$1000.
- There have been discussions about creating budget allocations for giveaways.
- The current budget allocation for Projects Board is \$45,000, but this could be increased.
- The budget for Lawn Parties is \$80,000, but this could be increased.
- The entire budget for this semester is \$200,000, but some expenses have already gone through, so the budgetary allocations are based on a total budget of \$190,000.

3. Ideas Incubator Update: Allen Liu (10 minutes)

- There are discussions about reviving the Ideas Incubator in a way that works with the virtual school year.
- Creating a list of administrators who could be involved in the Ideas Incubator.
- USG will be “crowd sourcing” some of the programming and coming up with activities for students.
- The goal of the Ideas Incubator will be to help students develop their ideas, connecting them with relevant administrators, and narrowing down possibilities.

Suggestions from the Senate:

- Incorporate the Ideas Incubator with the referendum process because all student ideas will be eventually passed to the administration.
- Clearly delineate how much time administrators are expected to invest in projects to ensure that processes are running as efficiently as possible.
- Make the distinction between the USG Labs Project and the Ideas Incubator more clear.
- Narrow the scope of the type of projects that the Ideas Incubator can take on.
